Idaho – On August 9, Wind Powering America Technical Director Larry Flowers and Curtis Framel from the U.S. Department of Energy's Western Regional Office presented the 2005 Carpe Ventem (Seize the Wind) Award to James Carkulis of Exergy Development Group LLC.
